

I've got a pre-December offer – what do I do now?

What you're thinking

I'm happy with the pre-December offer and don't want to be considered for other courses in the December or January offer rounds.

I'd like to keep my options open and I think I'd like to try for other courses in the December offer round.

I've changed my mind about what I'd like to do and I don't want my offer at all now. I want to change my preferences and be considered in the December offer round.

What you need to do

Accept or defer your place according to the instructions in your offer email.

Don't accept/defer/reject your offer. Move the offered first preference code to a lower preference. Add other courses as higher preferences by 18 December.

Don't accept/defer/reject your offer. Remove the offered first preference code, and add other courses by 18 December.

What will happen in the December offer round

You'll have secured your place and won't be considered for any further preferences in the December or January offer rounds.

You'll get offered one of your higher preferences if you're eligible, and if there are places available. You may be reoffered your pre-December offer, but there's no guarantee.

You'll get offered one of your new preferences if you're eligible, and (for quota courses) if your qualifications are competitive.
