### **2017 SECOND ROUND UNIVERSITY OFFERS THROUGH TISC**

Second round university offer information is now available to applicants on the Tertiary Institutions Service Centre's website, [www.tisc.edu.au](http://www.tisc.edu.au).

There were a total of 18,361 applications in the 2016/2017 admissions period, including 12,498 from WACE students (last year: 18,336 applications, including 12,592 from WACE students).

84% of university applicants have received an offer. There were a total of 15,390 offers over the two rounds of offers, with 76% of offers going to first preferences. At the same time last year the universities had made 16,465 offers, with 78% going to first preferences. 2016 WACE students received 11,349 offers for 2017 university entry (91% of WACE applicants). The 2015 WACE cohort received 11,815 offers for 2016 entry (94% of WACE applicants).

Since the main round of offers in January 9,672 people have already enrolled (10,344 last year).

This year there were 1,574 new offers in the second round (1,586 last year). These were made to a mixture of new applicants and existing applicants who missed an offer in the main round or who have now been offered a course higher in their preferences.

Also included in the second round of offers are people who were offered places in the main round but had chosen to wait in the hope of being offered one of their higher preferences in the current round. The universities have reoffered 1,356 places (1,478 last year) to applicants who chose to use this 'safety net' for their main round offer.

There are always a number of people who do not take up their offers or who choose to defer studies until the following year. There are 1,227 applicants who have not accepted their first preference offer from January's main round (1,413 last year). A further 1,566 applicants have chosen to defer their study until 2018 (1,643 at the same time last year).
