#### 1 TISC GUIDE CORRECTION: JANUARY CLOSING DATE

The printed TISC Guide contains a misprint in the table of important dates on page 2.  
The fifth row of the table should read (change in **red**):

Thursday, 5 January 2017 11.00 pm	Final closing date for you to apply, or add/re-arrange preferences for main round offers.
4.30 pm	<b>NOTE:</b> TISC and the universities will do their best to process and consider for the main round of offers applications received up to today. However, any delays in receipt of supporting documentation may impact on this goal.
	Final date for you to provide documents/transcripts of results of 2016 studies for the main round of offers.

#### 2 EARLY OFFERS TRIAL: UWA MINIMUM ATAR CONDITION

The University of Western Australia has advised that its early Engineering offers will be conditional on students achieving an actual ATAR of 80 or more, in addition to satisfying English language requirements and achieving a scaled score of 50 or more in Mathematics Methods.
