

International Colleges/Schools 2025 Year 12 students Getting Started on TISConline

Dear Year 12 student,

The following information will help you get started on TISConline.

WACE students (including those doing ATAR, General subjects or VET Certificates)

- You've been pre-registered with TISConline based on data from the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA).
- Your **User ID** is your 8-digit SCSA Student Number. If unsure, seek help from your school.
- Your **initial/default password** is the first two characters of your family name (in lower case), followed by your full date of birth in the format ddmmyyyy.

For example:

Family name	Date of birth	initial/default password
Pratt	10 September 1996	pr10091996
A'Court	2 December 1992	a'02121992
MacBeth	28 April 2001	ma28042001
K Sivan	17 January 2000	k 17012000

- Visit www.tisc.edu.au and click **Login** on the top right of the screen to begin.
- At first log in, you'll be prompted to change your initial/default password.
- Please check that your personal details on our system are correct.
- You'll get an email confirming your successful registration/activation.

Access ATAR/University Admissions Advice Letter (UAAL)

Results will be available on TISConline when they are released. We encourage you to test your credentials before the release date. The pre-ordered printed copies of the ATAR Certificate and UAAL ordered through your school will be posted to the school.

Applying to university in Western Australia

Northern Hemisphere students who wish to study at a university in Western Australia should apply to the university directly. You cannot apply through TISC unless you're an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident or New Zealand citizen; if you have a query, don't hesitate to contact TISC.
