

SPECIAL TERTIARY ADMISSIONS TEST (STAT)

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES WITHOUT ADEQUATE IDENTIFICATION

On the day of the test, you will be required to show photo-bearing identification in hard-copy format, such as a: current passport, current Australian driver's licence/learner's permit, current Working with Children Card, WA Photo Card.

Your identification document **MUST** contain your name, your date of birth, a recent photograph (embedded in the card) and your signature.

A student or workplace identification card is only acceptable if it meets ALL of the criteria listed above.

If you do not possess any of the above forms of photo-bearing identification, you MUST obtain a statutory declaration, accompanied by a photograph which has been signed on the back by the witness to the statutory declaration.

Your Declaration must be completed and signed in front of someone who is described as an authorised witness under the *Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005* and who is **NOT** related to you by birth or marriage.

No TISC staff member can witness this declaration.

You cannot take your photo-bearing identification into TISC after the testing session, as this does not meet our requirements.

Your declaration should contain words to this effect:

I confirm that I, [your name in full], sat the Special Tertiary Admissions Test at [place where you sat the STAT] on [date you sat the STAT].

The completed Statutory Declaration together with the signed photograph must be provided on the day of the test or received by TISC **within 3 working days** of your test sitting.

Only the original completed Statutory Declaration and photograph is acceptable (ie. photocopies, faxes, emails and scans will not be accepted).

Your STAT results will not be available to you or the universities until after you have submitted the Statutory Declaration and signed photograph to TISC.
