

CIRCULAR 3 OF 2022

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1 YEAR 12 RESULTS ONLINE

All 2022 WACE students with at least one scaled score, will be able to access their TISC Universities Admission Advice Letter information (including scaled scores, ATAR and eligibility information for universities for the 2023 admission year) via the TISC website at www.tisc.edu.au.

Results will be available from **Sunday 18 December 2022**. The TISC office will be open on this day to answer enquiries.

2 UAAL and ATAR CERTIFICATE ORDERS

For those who wish to order official copy(ies) of their results, TISC now offers two options – the Universities Admission Advice Letter (UAAL) and the ATAR certificate. More information about the [UAAL](#) and [ATAR certificate](#) is available on the TISC website.

Students can order these documents when lodging their TISC application, or via the Registered User Function. This can be done even if the student is not applying for university through TISC. The cost is \$25.00 for the first copy and \$15.00 for each additional copy for any combinations of the two documents whether ordered together or separately.

3 UNIVERSITY OFFER DATES

The first major round of offers for Year 12 students will be available from **Friday 23 December 2022** with another major round of offers available on **Friday 20 January 2023**.

4 UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS

The application deadline for a [small number of courses](#) has passed, but applications for most courses are still open at www.tisc.edu.au, and will remain open until **19 December 2022** (for Main Round offers) and **15 January 2023** (for Second Round offers).

TISC encourages applicants, particularly those sitting WACE examinations, to complete their applications as soon as possible to give themselves maximum flexibility when results are released.

The TISC Board has confirmed applications for **Semester 1 2024 Admission** (for 2023 Year 12s and all other students) will open on **1 May 2023**.

5 CHANGING PREFERENCES

Once they have applied, students may change preferences as many times as they wish, subject to closing dates, without incurring any extra charge.

This year, applicants have only a short period of time following the release of Year 12 results, to reassess and rearrange their preferences for the Main Round of offers.

Preference changes for the Main Round will close at **11.59pm on Monday 19 December**.

TISC advises all 2022 Year 12 students to log in to the TISC website in the week leading up to results release, to ensure their user ID and password are working. There may be a high volume of calls and emails on the day of results release.

Following the release of Main Round offers, it will be possible for applicants to change preferences until **11.59pm on Sunday 15 January 2023**, in preparation for the second major offer round. This time between offer rounds is an opportunity to seek advice from TISC and/or the universities if an applicant did not receive an offer or is unsure about their options.

6 2023, 2024 AND 2025 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL LEAVERS

9 YEAR 12 STUDENTS INTENDING TO SIT STAT

[STAT](#) is not intended as an entry pathway for Year 12 students. Year 12 students who complete ATAR English, ATAR EAL/D, or ATAR Literature, but do not achieve university

Competence in English, may book STAT Written English as a second chance to meet these requirements, after their Year 12 results are released. They will be able to book into the 4 January or 7 January sessions.

Year 12 students studying General English, EAL/D, or Literature, may not sit STAT until after the conclusion of the WACE examinations. If they have permission from at least one university they can book into the 26 November, 4 January, or 7 January sessions. For more information on how to obtain permission, students should check with TISC or with the university where they wish to study. Booking forms will not be processed if a student is not eligible to sit.

10 UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

Students applying for university through TISC should provide their USI as part of their application. This is not a compulsory field this year and will not affect the outcome of an application, but successful applicants will need to provide their USI to the universities at the time of enrolment.

Applicants can create or retrieve their USI at www.usi.gov.au – once created, it stays with students for life and will maintain a register of all Nationally Accredited training and post-secondary study.

11 TISC REPORTS AVAILABLE TO SCHOOLS

TISC will produce two reports for schools concerning their 2022 Year 12 WACE students.

Both the register and report are dynamic and will be available for download from the secure TISC website. From this year schools will need to calculate their own ATAR-related statistics (eg mean, median, mode) from the data provided.

12 TISC PRESENTATIONS TO SCHOOLS IN 2023

TISC representatives are available to provide presentations to teachers, career practitioners, Year 12 students and/or parents most of 2023 (except from September to January).

These presentations can be done in person, or online via Microsoft Teams, subject to resourcing and travel time.

Presentations are tailored to the audience, the time of year and the amount of time allocated, and can cover the following topics as required:

- university admission requirements
- alternative entry pathways
- marks adjustment processes
- the application process
- structuring preferences
- the offer process
- offer response options

Presentations to regional areas are usually arranged from late June to late July (Mid West and Great Southern) and from mid-August to late August (Goldfields and South West). The online presentations provide flexibility outside those windows.

Bookings fill quickly, and if you leave it until Term 2 next year, you are likely to miss out!
